# **Remote Learners**

- Our students who will continue to learn remotely will follow the same daily and bell schedule as our in-person learners.
- Classes will incorporate both remote and in-person learners.
- Though we are separated physically our school and our classes are still a learning community.

**Asynchronous -** During this time students can finish assigned classwork, engage in assigned purposeful practice, read, engage in <u>digital resources through CLEVER</u>, and connect with teachers or other staff members during Office Hours.

## **ARRIVAL**

#### **Self-Certification**

- All students must be self-certified by their parents or guardians before arriving at school each day. Students will not be allowed in the building unless it is done that morning.
- All students will engage in temperature checks when they enter the building.
- Students must stay home if displaying one or more symptoms. Please report this to the school office at 708.450.2023.

#### **Absences**

- When should I keep my child at home?
  - o If your child has experienced any of the symptoms listed below over the last 24 hours that are atypical and not related to a pre-existing condition.
    - Fever or feeling feverish (chills, sweating)
    - New cough
    - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
    - Sore throat
    - Muscle aches or body aches
    - Vomiting or diarrhea
    - New loss of taste or smell
    - Chills
    - Fatigue
    - New or unusual headaches
    - Congestion

## **Student Arrival & Staff Supervision Begins**

- Students should not be on school grounds prior to 8:30 for PreK and 8:45 for Kindergarten-5<sup>th</sup> grades.
- Everyone must wear masks upon arrival and remain physically distanced, 6-feet apart.
- There will be physical-distancing markers posted to help students know where to stand in line.
- Students will enter into the building at **8:30** for **PreK** and **8:45** for **Kindergarten-5**<sup>th</sup> **grades** and go directly to their first class of the day.
- Students will be required to use a hand sanitizing station before entering their classroom and have their temperatures checked during arrival.

# ENTRANCE LOCATIONS AND TRAFFIC FLOW

For a variety of reasons, the student drop-off time can be a challenging one, even during a normal year. We cannot stress enough the importance of patience and flexibility as we safely bring our students into the building. With everyone's help and cooperation, we can ensure a successful arrival and dismissal for our students.

Bus Students or Tardy Students-Door A (Main Entrance)


# Do's

## **Bus Guidelines**

At the bus stop...

- 1. Students should arrive at their stop 5 minutes before pickup in order to be sure they make the route.
- 2. Be socially distant and stay 6 feet apart from others at the bus stop
- 3. Stay off the street at all times while waiting for the bus
- 4. If you have to cross the street, cross in front of the bus
- 5. All students must get on/off at their assigned stop
- 6. Students will fill up the bus from the back to the front
- 7. Wear a mask at all times

#### On the bus...

- 1. Keep your mask on at all times
- 2. Do what your driver asks
- 3. Stay in your seat, facing forward-there will be no switching seats
- 4. No screaming or yelling
- 5. No eating or drinking while on the bus
- 6. Stay physically distanced as you leave the bus

#### DISMISSAL

- Students will exit the same door that they use for arrival.
- We once again ask for your flexibility and patience with this process so that we dismiss all students safely.
- While the official dismissal time is 11:15 for PreK and 12:30 for Kindergarten-5<sup>th</sup> grades, we will dismiss bus students first followed by our walkers and car riders.
- Students should leave school property at dismissal and maintain 6 foot social distancing while exiting the building and leaving school property.
- Students are expected to wear masks at all times on school property.
- Please pull over to the parking spots on Division St. or pick-up zone on 9<sup>th</sup> Ave when picking up your child. For the safety of all children, you should never stop on the road to pick up your child.

#### **CLASSROOMS**

- Students are expected to remain seated at their desks to the greatest extent possible.
- Students will have assigned seats with a transparent desk shield to separate them from classmates.
- Desks/tables are arranged to accommodate guidelines.
- While paper/pencil and other activities will occur, students will continue to utilize their assigned devices while at school.
- Please make sure devices are fully charged the night before.
- Classroom teachers will specify which books students will need to bring to school each
  day
- Please note that materials will not be shared amongst students.
- Each classroom is equipped with disinfectant wipes for cleaning purposes and a touchless hand sanitizing station.
- Classrooms will be cleaned and disinfected each day by our custodial staff.

#### **CLEAN HANDS**

- In addition to wearing a mask and maintaining 6-feet social-distancing, keeping hands clean will help keep everyone in our building healthy and safe.
- When necessary, students will be directed to wash hands for at least 20 seconds with soap and water.
- The following are times when the use of hand sanitizer (provided by the school district) and handwashing is expected:
  - Before entering any classroom
  - After using a tissue to blow your nose
  - After using the bathroom (handwashing)

## **MASKS**

- Wear the mask over your nose and mouth and secure it under your chin AT ALL TIMES.
- Please note bandanas and neck gaiters are not approved.

#### **WATER BOTTLES**

- Students are encouraged to bring a water bottle from home.
- Touchless water bottle filling stations were installed.
- When drinking water in the classroom, students may be asked to keep their masks on and slightly lift up the bottom of their mask with one hand to take a sip of water.

### MOVING THROUGH THE BUILDING

- Everyone is asked to walk on the right side of the hallway.
- Floor markers have been installed to maintain six feet of physical distance.
- Social distancing guidelines are posted throughout the building.

# **BACKPACKS**

- Students will be able to use a backpack to carry any necessary materials throughout the day.
- Please work with your child to prioritize what learning materials are necessary, and what is not necessary to pack on a daily basis.

## **BATHROOM USAGE**

- Classes will have assigned bathroom breaks to minimize traffic.
- Staff will monitor bathrooms to ensure students are washing their hands and overcrowding does not occur.
- Bathrooms will be cleaned and sanitized between classes.

#### SIGNING STUDENTS IN & OUT OF THE BUILDING

• Please call the school office in advance to arrange for early dismissals or late arrivals.

#### **COMMON FAQS**

## What if my child forgets their mask at home?

• Extra masks will be available if a student does not have one.

#### What will it look like when my child arrives at school?

- o Students will enter through their assigned door (See above).
- o Students will have their temperature checked by a staff member.
- Students will move directly to their classroom maintaining 6 ft apart.

## • What time can I drop-off my student in the morning?

- The school will open at 8:30 for PreK and 8:45 for Kindergarten-5th grade students.
  - Please plan your arrivals accordingly given that students will not be allowed to enter the building <u>until their assigned times</u>.
- What time should I pick up my student?
  - PreK students will be dismissed at 11:15am, Kindergarten-5<sup>th</sup> grade students will be dismissed at 12:30pm.
- When does my child need to put their mask on?
  - Students must wear a mask on school grounds at all times.
  - Please have your child put on their mask prior to exiting your vehicle.
- Can my child bring food to school?
  - o No.
    - Students are not allowed to bring food to avoid needing to remove the mask to eat. Please make sure your child has breakfast prior to arrival.
- Can I send my child to school with a water bottle?
  - Yes.
    - All students can bring a refillable water bottle to school.
      - Refillable water bottle stations are available.
      - No drinking fountains will be used.

## • How do I report that my child will be absent from "in-person" instruction?

- Call the attendance phone number at 708.450.2023 and if nobody answers please leave a message.
- What if my child has COVID-like symptoms, but is well enough to be online virtually?
  - Still complete the process above. The child will not be marked absent.
    - Complete the student "Self-Certification" by answering "yes" to the appropriate question.
    - Call the attendance phone number 708.450.2023 and leave a message. State: "My child will be remotely learning today."
  - The student will be able to access all lessons via remote learning platforms.
  - The student will be marked "present" as long as they attend their classes remotely.

## • Will uniforms be required?

- Yes, we will continue to follow the district's uniform policy.
  - Students will be required to wear a light blue or white collared shirt. School spirit wear is allowed.
  - Students will be required to wear navy blue pants. School spirit wear is allowed.
